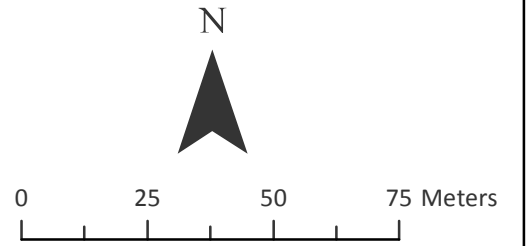


Valleyview Centennial Park Facility Map

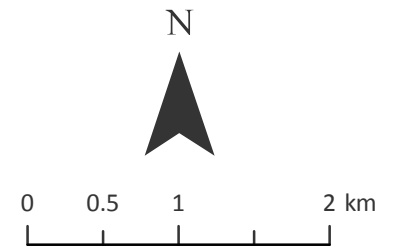

About the Park

Valleyview Centennial Park is a recreation park located alongside the Trans Canada Highway in Valleyview. This park is used extensively for soccer and also has a multi-purpose rink used for lacrosse and road hockey. There is also a picnic shelter that was constructed by the Valleyview Lions Club that is used to picnics, bbq's, etc.

How to get there:

-  From West Head east on Trans-Canada Hwy/BC-1 E/BC-97 S, Turn right onto Highland Rd, Turn left onto Trans Canada Hwy East Frontage Rd, Turn right onto Park Dr, and the destination will be on the left
-  Head west on Trans-Canada Hwy/BC-1 E/BC-97 S, and turn left onto Highland Rd, and turn left onto Trans Canada Hwy East Frontage Rd, turn right onto Park Dr, and the destination will be on the left
-  From North: Get on Trans-Canada Hwy/BC-1 E/BC-97 S in Kamloops from Southern Yellowhead Hwy/BC-5 S and Battle St, merge onto Trans-Canada Hwy East Frontage Rd to Park Dr., turn right onto Highland Rd, turn left onto Trans Canada Hwy East Frontage Rd, and turn right onto Park Dr. The destination will be on the left.
